## Please bring with you to class:

Materials fee of \$50 per student. This fee will include four scarves of different fibers and weaves for each student to insure successful dyeing of the folds and acquaint them with differences. Students pay this directly to the instructor for supplies provided.

I hemp/rayon gauze scarf

I wool gauze scarf

I silk chiffon scarf

I light rayon scarf

Japanese binding vinyl

Binding materials

A handout in color of +4 pages

Dyes for the class vats

List of supplies students will be required to bring:

Additional fabric - PLEASE LIMIT TO 4 PER PERSON -open weave natural fibers, e.g. chiffon, organza, raw silk gauze, cotton from India (Dharma), bubble silk gauze (Exotic Silks), twisted silk seersucker (Exotic silks), Essex cloth (Dharma), linen, lawn, heavy cotton gauze (Dharma), linen/rayon (Dharma), cotton gauze Note that charmeuse, satin, twill, and jacquard weaves will generally not produce satisfactory results with origami folds.

Students will need to scour any fabric that they are bringing to dye in the class. If you have not scoured fabric before, please bring your fabric to the first class. Time will be set aside to scour pieces at the end of class.

## Pieces should be at least 15" wide and from 24" to 72" in length

3-4 sheets of 8 ½ x 11 copier paper Note taking materials Long needle with large eye Long needle with medium eye Spray bottle for water Fabric scissors 15"-18" ruler (preferably with both metric and English units) Fugitive markers either light or water type

Straight pins (preferably with flat heads)

Binding materials of various thicknesses (twines, strings, cords)

Pairs of wooden or plastic blocks (circles, squares, rectangles)
Exam gloves
A gas mask is required for anyone wanting to discharge one piece
Gloves designated for indigo for anyone wanting to dye with indigo
I gallon Ziploc bags for carrying wet fabric

There will be time reserved at the end of class for clean up. Please help this process go quickly by assisting the instructor.
