Understanding Sergers

Please bring with you to class:

Serger in good working order

Serger accessories:

- Operating manual for your machine
- Power cord and/or foot control!!!
- Needle plates, feet, and supplemental instructions for accessories
- Necessary tools for changing needles, needle plate, looper converter (if appropriate to your machine)
- Extra needles – just in case!! Make certain they are the correct system/type/size for your machine.
- Spools of serger thread in different colors to help in threading and diagnosing stitch quality issues. All threads must be of the same brand/weight/type/quality.

A variety of fabric samples (muslin, light-weight woven, sheers, knits of differing weights, etc. - whatever you have available or want to learn about). Bring extra to share with others.

Small brush for removing lint

Thread clip/scissors

Fabric scissors

Tweezers/looper threaders, needle holders

Paper and pen/pencil for note taking

Reading glasses, if needed

Bring a desire to learn new skills, a positive "can-do" attitude, and a sense of humor!

Please try to arrive a few minutes early to set up your work station. The classroom will be open 15 minutes before the start of class.
