## Materials:

Armature Wire – 14 gauge (can be substituted with wire hanger)

Tapestry Needle - #18

Yarn of any color, thickness (grab more than you think that you'll need just in case)

Other Textile Materials - fabric, fleece, rope, etc. (grab more than you think that you'll need just in case)

Hammer and nails (nails need to have a substantial nail head, size can vary)

Chain Nose Pliers

Stretcher bars – two 12" and two 18" (can be substituted with a wooden picture frame)
