LETTER FROM THE BOARD PRESIDENT & EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

Textile Center’s 25th year was filled with milestones, events, and exhibitions that demonstrated our organization’s vitality. The 2020 fiscal year began on April 1, 2019, with a festive birthday party in our auditorium that brought together our founders and friends, and included a 25th Anniversary Gala, Fashion Show, and Silent Auction on October 21, 2019 chaired by Linda McShannock and Lisa Steinmann.

During the year we hosted a distinguished roster of guest teaching artists, and presented three international tours – to Morocco, Japan, and India – as well as a group excursion to visit the Santa Fe International Folk Art Market.

Also among the milestones: Textile Center was invited to join McKnight Foundation’s cohort of arts organizations collaborating with its distinguished fellowship program for midcareer artists. In June 2019 Textile Center was awarded a three-year grant to administer the new McKnight Fiber Art Fellowships, and by January 2020, we announced the first two fellows receiving \$25,000 each: Liz Miller & Eun-Kyung Suh.

On March 11, 2020, we celebrated our newest Spun Gold Award winners – Carolyn Halliday, Nancy Mambi, Mary Skoy, and Ginny Smith, the highest award offered to honor artists and advocates for a lifetime dedication to fiber art. This event occurred on the same day that the World Health Organization declared the COVID-19 outbreak a global pandemic.

Within the next few days, we closed Textile Center. For our Board of Directors and staff, the final weeks of our 2020 fiscal year brought forth an unprecedented challenge to navigate through the most severe crisis in our history. We worked to develop our COVID-19 Action Plan that outlined our top priorities:

- To ensure the health and safety of our staff, board, teaching artists, students, volunteers, and patrons.
- To support our dedicated staff members, the lifeblood of our organization who ensure that we fulfill our mission day-in and day-out.
- To maintain the health and viability of our organization through wise stewardship of our financial resources, effective communication with our large Textile Center family, and a “can-do” spirit of optimism and hope.

During the month of March, Textile Center donated more than 90 bags of cotton fabric, each weighing between 1.5 to 2 pounds each, from our World’s Largest Textiles Garage Sale stash to support mask makers to help fill an urgent need for masks for local congregate care centers. It was so impressive to witness the ways in which our members, including our affiliate textile guilds, jumped in with their sewing skills to meet the massive call for masks during these early days of the pandemic.

As you read this, the good news is that Textile Center has demonstrated its resilience, and is finding its way forward through the pandemic thanks to you, our most supportive fiber art family.

As we report on Fiscal Year 2020, we don’t want COVID-19 to cloud the successes we had throughout the year. The strength of our staff, programs, services, and financials have helped Textile Center weather the pandemic crisis. Despite our closure in March, which included the cancellation of classes, the suspension of our retail sales, as well as a dramatic drop in the stock market that led to a substantial loss in our Joan Mondale Endowment, we ended the year with a net income of \$139,344 for the year.

Fiscal year 2020 was the second year in a row that our operations were more than \$1 million, and during the past six years, Textile Center enjoyed 90% growth... rising from \$760,443 in income in 2014-2015, to \$1,274,122 in 2019-2020.

All these successes, which our outlined in this annual report, are possible thanks to our dedicated board of directors and talented staff. We are especially grateful to our staff leaders: Director of Administration Nancy Gross, Director for Artistic Advancement Tracy Krumm, and Director of Finance Jayne Usery.

We look forward to when we are on the other side of this pandemic ... when we can gather again in person to celebrate our passion for fiber art and our commitment to the ongoing success of our beloved Textile Center.

Thank you for making our 25th Anniversary year a terrific success.

Thanks to a generous capital gift from Mary's husband, Jim Harris, Textile Center's architect David Salmela and his team designed an elegant renovation of the gallery space. The Mary Giles Gallery is a wonderful companion to our Joan Mondale Gallery, and we're pleased that Mary's memory will live on through this gallery at Textile Center.

Step Up June 2019

Textile Center hosted one week of a 9-week internship experience in collaboration with Target, University of Minnesota, and North High in Minneapolis that provided hands-on experience in garment design. Students learned surface design techniques to print and dye yardage that was used in garments of their own creation, culminating in a fashion show at the end of the program.

Summer Camps June – August 2019

In the summer of 2019, we offered 25 textile camps for young students, ages 6–16, with a passion for the arts. Campers learn skills including how to use a sewing machine, weave on a loom, care for real silkworms as they dye their own fabric, and even take a field trip to a Twin Cities design studio to learn about the fashion industry.

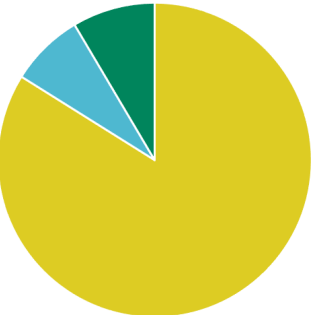

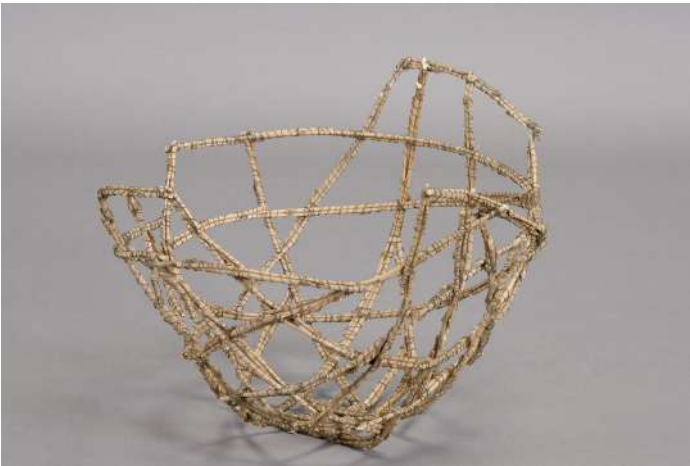

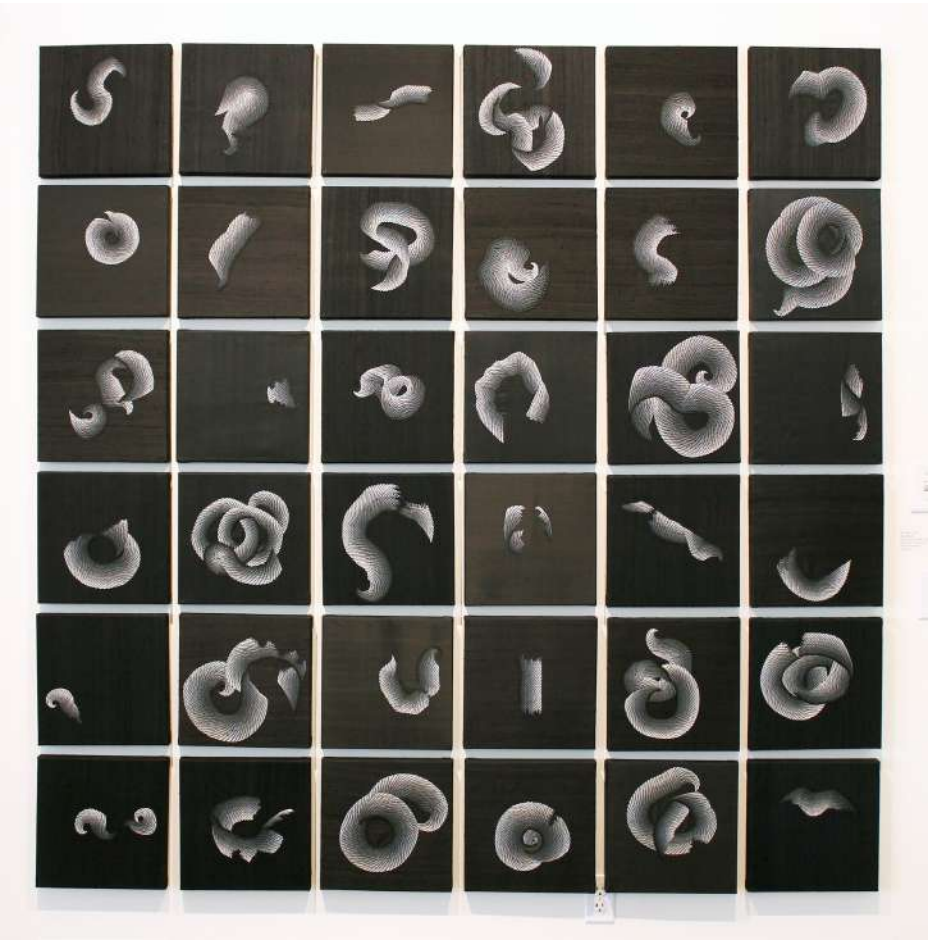

“Stitches are sacred, because stitches hold together a designer gown. Stitches mend a monk's worn garment. Stitches are found in operating rooms that mend people's organs. They mend rent and torn skin. Stitches hold together the pieces of a quilt that welcome a new baby into the world. They also close winding sheets. Stitches decorate. They're a language. They're sacred.

I think about this thread, which I imagine to be something that does not perish – it winds around this planet thousands of times. 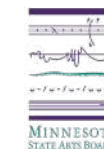
