If you choose to supply your own materials and don't want to purchase the kit, please source these items: <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Ample supply of fabric scraps from non-stretchy fabric. Quilting cotton is ideal. Usable scraps are generally larger than 1" x 2"2. 1-yard cotton fabric of your choice for bag lining (more specifically, 2 pieces that are 20 x 24 inches each)3. 2 strips of fabric, 6" x 26" each (for the handles.... This can be the same or different from your lining fabric)
thread (any color)
Sewing machine, in good working condition
Fabric scissors (or cutting mat and rotary cutter, if you have it already)
Iron and ironing surface
