Please bring with you to class:

Materials fee \$15, payable to the instructor by cash or check, at the time of workshop. For this fee, each student will receive:

- A variety of high quality quilting fabrics to use for the two blocks they are making
- Paper foundations
- Heat resistant batting to use in the mug mat
- Ground walnut shells to use in the pincushion
- Buttons and beads to choose from for the pincushion

Please bring from your own supplies:

- A sewing machine in good working order—don't forget the foot pedal and power cord!
- A spool of 50 weight sewing thread – this is regular cotton or polyester thread
- Scissors
- Pins

If you have it:

- Rotary cutter
- 12" quilting ruler
- A point turner
- Pressing tool such as a wooden roller or a Clover Press and Roll
- Cutting mat, if you have one

There will be time reserved at the end of class for cleanup. Please help this process go quickly by assisting the instructor.
