#### Please bring with you to class:

- \$60 materials fee, payable to instructor on the first day, includes Japanese *ro-fude* #8 wax brush, *Surikome* #5 dye brush, Wax dauber, Stencil paper, 23-page Rozome booklet, Joint use of *sansei sen-ryo* dyes, Joint use of Bees /Soy wax
- pencil/ eraser/ sketch book/ charcoal pencil #3B or 4B
- Some of your own designs or symbols for reference
- a few sheets of tracing paper and carbon paper
- scissors/ needle/ cotton thread
- 2 cheap 1 1/2" to 3" paint brushes, often called 'chip' brushes. (**not** synthetic bristles)
- approx. 2 yards med. weight (14mm +) silk of your own, prepared for dyeing
- 2 small clean towel rags
- 4 - 5 clip clothes pins
- 1 cello sponge
- wooden stretcher bars or commercial system for stretching fabric (16 x 26")
- thumb tacks or push pins/ rubber gloves
- Exacto knife or blade with handle for cutting stencils
- a rubber brayer or roller with metal mount and wooden handle if possible (not made of plastic if you have any choice)
- 4 - 5 small glass jars (baby food jars are ideal)

There will be time reserved at the end of class for cleanup. Please help this process go quickly by assisting the instructor.
