Sewing Stretchy Stuff: Performance Wear Colleen Kahn

Please bring with you to class:

- Materials fee \$15, payable to the instructor (includes practice fabric, elastics, stones, glues, and templates).
- Sewing machine in good working order, with pedal. Machine needs to have at least one stretch stitch such as a broken zig-zag.
- Stretch needles (NOT ball point), in sizes 12-14
- Pattern for project from a knitwear specialist. Recommended brands are Jalie, Boo Designs (for kids), Kwik Sew, CKC Designs – most come multi-sized. Can print at home/tape together (this option is no fun) or have printed at The Sewing Lounge, Kinkos, or neighborhood print shop for about \$10-15. Print the entire size range.
- Test fabric STRONGLY RECOMMENDED must have same stretch as real fabric.
- Fabric for project, including lining (most projects at least line the front; I like to fully line skating costumes for a tiny bit more warmth)
- Thread to match
- Usual sewing tools: tape measure, pins or clips, seam ripper, shears and little scissors, etc
- Tweezers or wax picking sticks for stoning
- Elastic varieties to be discussed in class
- Stone varieties to be discussed in class
- Glue options to be discussed in class

Class outline

Week 1 – bring key measurements of wearer, pattern, pencils, tape, tape measure, paper scissors, and test fabric (if using)

- Measurements: Bust, waist, hip, full girth (all the way around body), leg elastic
- Making pattern adjustments
- Cutting test fabric, if time

Week 2

- Sewing mesh inserts
- Basic assembly

Week 3

• Edge finishes

- Elastic types
- Trial fitting, if time

Week 4

- Stoning visit from Rhinestones Unlimited
- Testing with glues and heat

There will be time reserved at the end of each class meeting for clean-up. Please help this process go quickly by assisting the instructor.
