Pattern Play: Ikat Weaving

Please bring with you to class:

- Materials fee of \$70, payable to the instructor at the start of the workshop, includes binding frame materials (48" x 10" frame; PVC elbows, 4/student to build frame); Nylon cord to secure warp, 1 pack clothesline type; Color handout booklet, about 20 pages; 5/2 and 3/2 Perle Cotton weaving yarn; addition cotton thread for binding ikat; ikat tape; Madder root from garden—red; Cosmos Flowers from garden—orange; Marigold—yellow-green; Weld (depending on crop)—yellow; Incising tool (this is optional and students can buy from Instructor if they want one, it is for removing the binding thread); and Heavy cotton yarn we will use from the bound resist; clear packing tape; graph paper
- Tape measure and 12" ruler
- Pencil and eraser; black felt tip pen (optional for design on graph paper)
- Sharp fabric scissors
- Warping board (a few warping boards will be available at TAC curtesy of the Weavers Guild)
- Umbrella Swift and ball winder if you have one (optional, some will be available on site)
- 2 small plastic buckets, large enough for your warp and weft (for example 2 gallon is fine)
- Loom: Students will weave on table or floor looms. Students are welcome to provide their own loom or use one of the Weavers' Guild's looms. Please email education@weaversguildmn.org with your preference. If you plan to use your own loom, please include the brand name and model of the loom you will be bringing.

There will be time reserved at the end of class for clean-up. Please help this process go quickly by assisting the instructor.
