Please bring with you to class:

- Materials fee payable to the instructor: \$20 to cover dyes, inks, and wooden blocks used in class.
- One yard (min) or two yards (for kaftan) of fine count cotton or silk fabric (must be 100% cotton, 100% silk, or blend of silk and cotton; no synthetics). Fabric can be plain (undyed or single color) or printed with a pattern. If bringing printed fabric, opt for light to medium hues for better results when overdyeing or reworking the fabric in class. Fabrics with light to medium weight (not too thick) will work best.
- For students interested in creating a kaftan on the second day of the workshop, please bring a sewing machine in good working order. There will be a Textile Center sewing machine available for shared student use for anyone without a machine.

There will be time reserved at the end of class for clean-up. Please help this process go quickly by assisting the instructor.
