Please bring with you to class:

- Sewing machine in good working order (don't forget the foot pedal and power cord!)
- Pre-preprinted pattern
- Fashion fabric (as directed from the pattern, wool is highly recommended)
- Lining fabric (as directed by pattern)
- Buttons for project (as directed by pattern)
- Coordinating thread (based on your chosen fashion fabric)
- Support Materials: Students have the option to bring their own support materials to class or purchase a materials kit from the Instructor. This optional materials kit costs \$60 and includes muslin for test garment, cotton twill tape, wool felt for under color, hymo interfacing, shoulder pads, sleeve heads, and weft-insertion fusible interfacing. For students who wish to purchase this materials kit from the instructor, please preorder before January 28th by emailing the instructor directly at colleen@stitchmasters.org. Instructor will source premium findings from Bias Bespoke.

Alternatively, students may bring their own support materials:

- o muslin for a test garment (optional)
- o 1/4" cotton twill tape, 2 yards
- o wool felt for under collar, 1/4 yard
- o light to medium weight hymo interfacing, about 1.5 yard of 45" wide or 1 yard of 60" wide
- o shoulder pads
- o sleeve heads
- o small remnant of weft-insertion fusible interfacing, about 6"x20"

- o B Black and Sons (online) all materials
- o Fabric Mart (online) designer deadstock fashion fabric and lining, but hit-and-miss
