Coiled Rope Bowls with Kris Livingston

Materials needed for class:

- Working sewing machine with zig zag stitch.
- Zig zag foot, ideally one that allows you to see your stitches.
- Total of $\frac{3}{4}$ yard of cotton fabric for a medium bowl. Choose a variety of your favorite coordinating colors. Cut into $\frac{3}{4}$ -inch strips. You do not need to prewash fabrics or cut on the bias. (You can also use yarn or ribbon.)
- Basic sewing thread in colors to match your fabrics.
- Size 14 or 16 universal needle.
- 50 feet or more of clothesline. (See below)
- Small quilt clips or clothespins.
- Tool such as a stylus or chopstick to push your bowl as it forms.
- Basic school glue stick.
- Scissors, pins, small ruler, seam ripper.

Before Class Prep

- Cut your strips
- Wind two bobbins to match the thread(s) you will use.

Where to find clothesline:

- Option 1- Purchase 3/16-inch or 1/4-inch diameter clothesline from a hardware store. Choose cotton or a cotton/polyester blend. Choose one without a plastic core.
- Options 2- Purchase 100% cotton clothesline made for crafts.
