

Textile Center Supply List

Jelly Roll Rug Supplies

Please bring with you to class:

1. Sewing machine with zig-zag stitch at least 5.5mm wide.
2. Smooth bottomed foot with an opening for zig-zag stitch
3. Size 14 or 16 sewing machine needle for the placemat
4. Size 10 or 12 sewing machine needle to join strips
5. 10 pre-cut strips of coordinating fabrics 2 ½ by 42-44 inches. Bring extra strips in case you want other colors. You can use a jelly roll, especially if you plan to make more placemats to match, but you do not need to. A large jelly roll will make 4 coordinating place mats.
6. 100 % Cotton batting cut into 2 ¼ inch strips. You will need enough strips to equal the yardage of your fabric strips. Purchase of Bosal Katahdin On-A-Roll speeds the process, especially if you plan to make more than one placemat. The batting is already precut on a convenient roll.
7. Spool and bobbin of coordinating thread. You can use embroidery thread or variegated thread. Do not use thick thread like quilting thread. Use one color or change during the project.
8. Quilting Clips

Optional:

- Extension table that fits around your machine.
- Magnetic seam guide or other gauge to hold strips in place as you sew.
- Jelly roll sasher tool.
- RJ Designs Jelly Roll Rug instructions for reference.
- Stiletto or chopstick.
- Glue stick for strips of batting.

There will be time reserved at the end of class for clean-up. Please help this process go quickly by assisting the instructor.
