Thinking Through Color: Natural Dyes on Wool

Please bring with you to class:

- Materials fee of \$90, payable to the instructor directly at the start of the workshop, includes all natural dyes, mordants, and modifiers; wool roving, fleece, and additional fibers to use during class including local alpaca, angora, wool types, and silk; silk scarf and/or other textiles to dye (as a cute example alongside fiber); and handouts.
- Your preferred carding/spinning tools and/or favorite accessories for felting. Textile Center has equipment for students who are not able to bring equipment from home.
- Any fiber, fleece, roving, braids, etc (dyed or undyed) that you have been eager to use but aren't sure where to start, bring and we can discuss ideas.
- Something that inspires you color-wise or that you are curious about recreating, a piece of art, textile, or even just an idea!
- Students may bring one small natural-fiber item from home to dye during class, time allowing. Instructor will also have available extra dyeable materials for purchase such as socks, yardage, silk scarves, etc.
- Wear clothes that you don't mind getting dirty
- Notebook/pen
- Apron (optional)

There will be time reserved at the end of class for clean-up. Please help this process go quickly by assisting the instructor.
